The Annual General Meeting of the Bonny Hills Progress Association will be held in the Community Hall on Tuesday March 16th commencing at 7.00pm. All residents are invited to attend. The AGM is an excellent opportunity for the community to hear reports on BHPA activities throughout the year and to have input into the direction of the BHPA for the subsequent years. Only financial members of the BHPA are eligible to be nominated for the Committee or to vote, but the good news is that membership is only \$10 per household!

One of the main areas for discussion will be Rainbow Beach Reserve as PMHC have invited the Association to develop a 'master plan' for the area: i.e. what we want the area to look like in the future. The master plan will then form the basis of further discussions with Council. Community input will be vital. Please come along to the AGM and have your say.

The changes to the speed limits on Ocean Drive proposed by the RTA have received qualified support from the BHPA. Two areas of concern are the bus stop near the Nursery which is still located in a 70kph zone and the 80kph speed limit in sections of the Bonny View Estate. The BHPA has written to the RTA and PMHC on these two issues. The Association still supports an 80kph limit on Ocean Drive between Bonny Hills and North Haven and we will be monitoring this section of road closely.

The Community support for Carols on the Deck was fantastic. Thank you! It was very rewarding for the organisers to see so many families enjoying the carols and other entertainment. And remember the next '**Bands on the Deck**' will be on **Saturday 6th March**.
