A boost for our budget: A very special thank you to those Bonny Hills locals who willingly gave up their Sunday 1st of May, to volunteer their services in the running of the Ironman race. The BHPA received in excess of \$400 which will meet half of our yearly insurance costs.

Best Value for Grant funds. The BHPA met recently PMHC staff to discuss:

1. Design of a Safety Bike Path for children at Rainbow Beach playground (\$9020 from CBPP)
2. Finalise the design of additional seating at this playground (\$1500 from the Kendall Op Shop)
3. The possibilities around bringing forward replacement of the Rainbow Beach amenities block given that the roof is now at the point of needing to be replaced at not inconsiderable cost. Considerable grant funding will be required to enable this to happen



BHPA members invited Dr David Gillespie to an on-site meeting to discuss possible funding for replacing the Rainbow Beach Amenities Block. No money changed hands but he did provide advice about how we might access federal funding.

Bonny Hills History Project. The BHPA sees this as a positive community building project where all community members can develop, share and appreciate the special history of this area. This has created great interest amongst a number of residents. We are currently collecting photographic memorabilia to make this available our community.

Pedestrian refuges.

You will have noted that two much needed refuges have been installed in our village along Ocean Drive. They look great but there have been a few teething problems which BHPA has been working with residents, local businesses and Council to resolve.
