A very successful Waste Water Treatment Plant Open Day was held on 29th May with over 100 people attending. It is a state of the art facility producing near drinking quality water, and has the capacity to handle a population of 12,000 people. Recycling will take waste water away from the plant and meet the needs of local sporting fields, as well as toilet flushing and cold water laundry in new developments.

-Coastal Track: There is \$104,000 allocated in Council's 2019/20 Operational Plan to upgrade and improve signage on the coastal track between Bonny's and North Haven.
