Due to the **complexity** and **importance** of current issues we have formed sub-committees to spread the load across:

- Water Treatment Plant releases – resulting from large volumes of stormwater getting into the sewerage system.
- Low quality of stormwater runoff into our creeks and ocean
- Lobbying to get a real fix for the dangerous Houston-Mitchell Pacific Highway intersection.
- Progressing actions in our Community Plan
 - Reserves MasterPlan is being revised following community feedback
 - Upgrade to walking track to N Haven is underway
 - Pathway upgrades need to be locked into Council's Operational Plans
 - Assessment of our natural floral and fauna assets
