-Stormwater Monitoring - Increased testing of Bonny's creeks and drains, thanks to a Council grant, has revealed marked increases in pollutants following rainfall events. A higher level of 'rubbish' is particularly evident in water coming out of the lake into the top end of Duchess Creek - probably due to adjacent development? Further testing will follow.
