
Peta and Amanda bringing a smile to displaced residents of Brigadoon Caravan Park, when at Francis Retreat.

## It is a series of complex problems.

- Water Treatment Plant overload is caused by large volumes of stormwater getting into the older parts of our sewerage system.
- Low quality stormwater runoff into our creeks and Ocean

## **Possible Solutions**

- Recycle as much tertiary treated water as possible, but this will only work in drier periods.
- Fix leaks and cross connections in the sewerage systems both here and in Lake Cathie.
- Retro fit bio-filtration systems for stormwater runoff where possible
- Install larger holding ponds
